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CTI Clinical Research Center has officially relocated to University Station

After many months of design and construction, we have completed the consolidation of our previous CRC locations to our new state-of-the-art clinical research facility at University Station in Norwood, Ohio. This site includes a 30 bed clinical pharmacology unit (CPU), a 6 bed sleep research lab, an outpatient clinic and a clinical pharmacy, providing sterile and non-sterile compounding services.

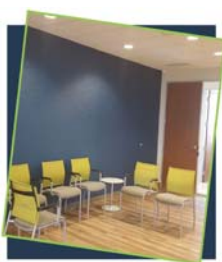


Combining these offerings at one location gives us the capability to conduct studies in the CPU in both normal healthy volunteers and special patient populations, which is a growing trend in research for regenerative medicine, rare disease, and oncology, as well as other areas. The outpatient clinic will continue to be a leading

site for later phase projects in a wide variety of therapeutic areas.



This new location also puts our unit right next to Xavier University, with prominent signage, proximity to Interstate 71, and easy access to public transportation, all of which will be a large benefit to recruiting patients.



CTI's global headquarters also recently relocated from the Cincinnati suburb of Blue Ash, Ohio 17 miles south to Covington, Kentucky's RiverCenter complex. Now, the CTI CRC is located only 5 miles from
